Introduction

This Privacy Policy explains how Financial Data Exchange, LLC, a Delaware limited liability company (“**FDX**”, “**we**” or “**us**”) collects and uses Information (as hereinafter defined) provided through our website, however accessed (the “**Website**”). By using our Website and providing Information to us you agree to the terms and conditions of this Privacy Policy.

Information Collection and Use

We collect the following personally identifiable information about our users: name, e-mail address, corporate web address, telephone number, business address, and other information voluntarily provided (“**Personal Information**”). This Personal Information is typically provided when users register, request the FDX API or sign of up for membership, subscriptions, communications, surveys, or to request information.

Other Information We Collect

At times we may also collect information which cannot be used to personally identify a user such as your server or connection’s unique identifier, the device, browser and version you are using, IP address, the web pages you visited prior to arriving to our Website and once you leave, action on the Website, and searches (“**Other Information**” together with Personal Information, the “**Information**”). We may also collect information through cookies or other similar tracking technology to provide you with a personalized user experience and analyze how we can best provide you targeted information.

Cookies

We may use technologies such as cookies or other similar mechanisms. A cookie is a piece of data sent from a website that is stored by a user’s computer. The cookies allow us to among other things, remember your computer’s preferences, measure effectiveness of communications, web features and settings, generate usage reports and gather statistical data. Please be aware that many web browsers provide the capability to configure your cookie settings, however disabling cookies may limit the functionality of our Website.

How We Use Your Information

We, our service providers and our vendors may use any Information collected from users in accordance with the terms hereof. Examples of how we may use your Information are below.

- Communicate with you about our organization, events or services.
- Analyze and improve the functionality of our Website.
- Improve our products, services, and business.
- Prevent, detect, or investigate security concerns, including fraud.
- Comply with applicable laws, regulations, or industry requirements.
- Fulfill any other purpose for which you provide it or consent.

Use and Disclosure of Information

Information may be shared with partners assisting FDX to perform certain tasks on our behalf, in compliance with this Privacy Policy. We do not share your Personal Information with third parties for their direct marketing purposes. FDX may also disclose Information if we believe that it is necessary to: (a) comply with applicable laws, regulations, or industry requirements; (b) respond to requests from a legal, regulatory or governmental authority; (c) enforce FDX's Terms and Conditions; (d) protect and defend FDX's operations, rights, privacy, safety or property, or that of its subsidiaries, affiliates, officers, employees, contractors, agents and/or partners; and (e) allow FDX to proceed with business transactions, pursue legal remedies, sell, transfer or assign FDX assets or limit damages.

Access and Control of Your Information

We enable you to have control over the accuracy of your Personal Information. You may send us an e-mail at admin@financialdataexchange.org to request access to, correct or delete any Personal Information that you have provided to us. We may not accommodate a request to delete or change information if we believe the change would violate any law or legal requirement, cause the information to be incorrect, or for any other legally allowable reason.

Your California Privacy Rights/ Do Not Track

California residents visiting our Website may request that we not automatically gather and track Information pertaining to their online browsing movements across the Internet. Such requests are typically made through Web browser settings that control signals or other mechanisms that

provide consumers the ability to exercise choice regarding the collection of personally identifiable information about an individual consumer's online activities over time and across third-party websites or online services. We do not currently utilize the capability to respond to web browser do not track signals or other mechanisms that provide you with the ability to exercise choice regarding the collection of this information.

Google Analytics

We use a tool called "Google Analytics" to collect information about use of the Website across devices. You can opt out of Google Analytics without affecting how you visit the Website.
